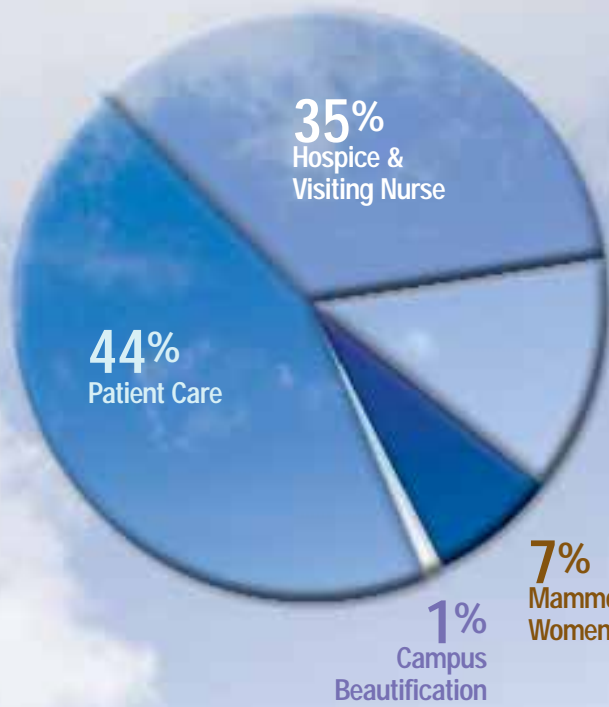

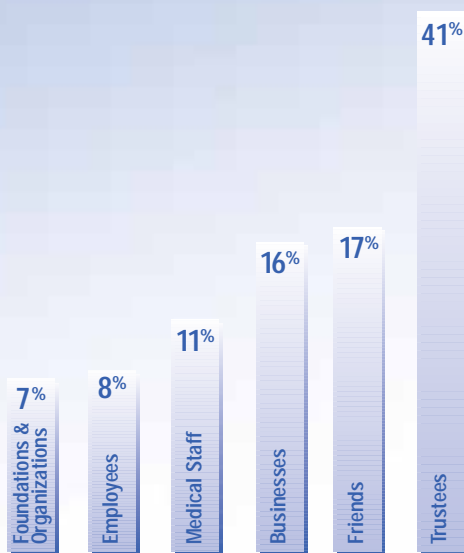

“**H**ome is Where Your Mom Is” ...“The Best Grandma”... These and other plaques adorn the room of Shirley Bencze, a 78-year-old, life-long Portage County resident, who is one of many grateful recipients of hospice care from the Robinson Visiting Nurse and Hospice program.

“During her younger years, my mother volunteered at the United Methodist Church of Streetsboro. She loved to cook and enjoyed helping with the special programs.

She also liked to travel a lot,” said Dave Bencze, her oldest son, who helps care for his mom. Now Shirley enjoys her four children and many grandchildren with the support of the hospice team.

This specialized team of professionals includes RNs, certified home care aides, licensed social workers and volunteers. To enhance Shirley’s quality of life, she also receives visits from the hospice massage therapist.

“Hospice has been a tremendous source of help to my mom,” said David. “They take care of whatever is needed,” he said.

And for Shirley, the hospice care she receives has become like family as well.

Contributions to the Robinson Memorial Hospital Foundation help make all of this possible for the nearly 25,000 annual home visits provided by Robinson Visiting Nurse and Hospice.

Mayle and Snyder are what many call “non-traditional” students. Snyder served in the United States Army as Chief of an Artillery Gun Crew, earning many medals and awards for his military service. Mayle had been a long-time firefighter/EMT for the Newton Falls Joint Fire District, also performing heroic acts of service in fighting fires and in search and rescue.

Both found themselves together again as patient care technicians in

the Robinson Memorial Hospital Emergency Department and both received KeyBank Foundation Nursing Scholarships through the Robinson Memorial Hospital Foundation to help them pursue their nursing careers.

“The reason I selected a career in nursing is because helping people is very rewarding to me,” Mayle said. “There is no greater feeling of satisfaction than assisting a patient in need or comforting a family member,” Mayle said. Mayle is grateful for the scholarship support he received and loves working at Robinson.

Snyder agrees. “During the time I have worked at Robinson Memorial Hospital, I have experienced a level of teamwork that I have only experienced in one other chapter of my life and that was when I was in the military. The care and compassion shown to all patients is second to none. The staff at Robinson is the most supportive group of co-workers I have ever known. I look forward to a long career at Robinson and being a valuable member of the Robinson team and the community as well.”
